



DEMOLITION NOTES

1. REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF ALL MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT AND FIXTURES SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.
2. REMOVE ALL EXISTING PARTITIONS, DOORS AND T.I.M. FRAMES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN. DOORS AND FRAMES ARE TO BE SALVAGED AND REUSED. RETURN UNUSED DOORS, FRAMES AND HARDWARE TO OWNER.
3. SET THE REFLECTED CEILING PLAN DWG. A-2 FOR CEILING REMOVAL REQUIREMENTS.
4. REMOVE EXISTING CARPET AND BASE AS DIRECTED BY THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE.

GENERAL NOTES

1. VERIFY ALL CONDITIONS AND DIMENSIONS IN THE FIELD. NOTIFY THE OWNER'S REP. OF ANY DISCREPANCIES BETWEEN THE DRAWINGS AND ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS.
2. MAINTAIN TEMPORARY DUST BARRIERS AT PERIMETERS OF CONSTRUCTION AREAS TO PREVENT INGRASSION OF DUST AND DEBRIS INTO OCCUPIED SPACES. PROTECT AND MAINTAIN EXISTING TRAFFIC WAYS. FULL LEGAL ENTRY ACCESS MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
3. THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR SHALL SCHEDULE ALL WORK IN EXISTING OCCUPIED SPACES WITH THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE. THE GC SHALL ALSO COORDINATE NECESSARY POWER AND DATA SHUTDOWNS WITH THE OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE.
4. PATCH ADJACENT SURFACES TO MATCH EXISTING WHENEVER DISTURBED BY DEMOLITION WORK OR NEW CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES.
